Visa, Travel, Hotel Reservations and Meal Tickets

Visa Information

International trainees who wish to enter Canada may need to first obtain a visa. Typically, those attending the training program will need to obtain a non-immigrant visa for a temporal stay. The visitor visa is a non-immigrant visa for persons desiring to enter Canada for business or pleasure. Please visit the Citizenship and Immigration Canada website for more information.

A letter of invitation does NOT guarantee the issuance of a visa. The decision to issue a visa is within the sole judgment of your local Embassy or Consulate. However, if you submit the following documents to the Embassy/Consulate, it would very likely facilitate the issuance of a visa:

An invitation letter issued by our training program

A notice from the hotel or residence that you have reserved hotel rooms (if the visa is not granted, you can cancel the reservation without charges)

A notice from our training program that you have paid the registration fee (if the visa is not granted, you can cancel the registration and receive a partial refund)

A notice from a travel agency that you have booked two-way tickets (Please check to be sure that if the Visa is not granted, you may cancel the tickets without penalty.)

Travel

Most people coming to Sydney arrive through the Halifax Stanfield International Airport (YHZ). The Halifax Stanfield International Airport is a bit far from Sydney, the location of training facility. The flight distance from Sydney Airport to YHZ is 190 miles (306 km) and about 395 miles (630 km) by road to the hotel located in Sydney, Nova Scotia, Canada. Trainees arriving YHZ on the weekend (only on Saturday) before training start week would be picked up from the airport by Doug Copp or otherwise you have to take a connecting flight or airport shuttle to Sydney based on availability.
